- **Shared learning:** Every half-term we will send home some learning that can be completed at home. We do not expect that all of them are completed but it would be lovely to see what you and your child are learning at home. We also **encourage daily reading with your child.**
- **Clothing and nappies:** Please make sure that you child is coming to school with enough nappies/pants and spare clothes for the day, we enjoy lots of messy and outdoor play so spare clothes are essential. All clothing must be named.

Our Recent Learning

At Willow Park, we continue to strive for excellence in all areas of education. This week in our classroom, we've had an exciting and busy time learning different subjects within our theme of Space.

In Phonics, the children have continued to enjoy environmental sounds, body percussion and using instruments to make rhythmic sounds and this will continue within our learning. Some children have been listening to the initial (first) sound in words and trying to say them.

As we wrote in the last newsletter, we will also continue to focus on pure sounds and if you haven't done so already, here is the video: Click here for a video that can help you and your child understand pure sounds.

In Maths this term, we've been busy counting to 10, singing fun number songs, and exploring the concepts of big and small. The children have enjoyed hands-on activities that help them recognise numbers, compare sizes, and develop early number sense in an engaging and playful way.

In other areas of learning, we have been encouraging **sharing and turn taking** (which some of our children find quite tricky), pretend play, reading plenty of books, sensory based play, building with a range of materials and learning about our own feelings and how we can express them.


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In Other News
